## Description

This Adaptive Greece Hub provides a series of tools (including: climate projections, adaptation actions, best practices etc.) and resources (adaptation policies on national/ European/ international level) in order to support decision making officials across various levels and sectors, in navigating and adapting relevant policies. It facilitates the assessment of regional and local impacts of climate change, the relevant preparedness and action - planning, while promoting adaptation measures. In addition to the aforementioned, the Hub aims to promote public awareness in a climate change related manner, share adaptation and best practices and support the implementation of the National Adaptation Strategy. From a wider point of view, it enhances transparency in policy making processes and connects Greece to the EU Climate-Adapt platform.
