"Schools for the Planet" is an initiative developed under the project 1Planet4All with the aim of uniting schools in their commitment to actively participate in the protection and advocacy of our planet.

Resources needed

At least one technological device, such as a computer or tablet, in order to be able to access the resources.

Age

5 to 18 years old

Expected outcomes

Through actions that contribute to reflecting on and taking action to combat climate change, it aims to build a community of learning in which everyone has a role.

Climate change

The tool aims to raise awareness about climate change, highlighting the crucial role of schools in fostering active citizenship.

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Risk prevention

The initiative contributes to risk prevention by empowering schools and their communities to take proactive measures, while educating them about climate change.

Management

While educator guidance enhances the activities, the tool is also accessible to students, particularly older ones, who can independently access the resources.

Others

Relevance to CRISEPAC Objectives

The tool aligns with the objectives of CRISEPAC, as it encourages active citizenship and enhances understanding of the causes of disaster risks among students and the school community.

Possible adaptations

The available handbooks and media materials are valuable resources for educating students on the topic in the classroom.

Weaknesses

While it does not explicitly focus on disaster risks, it touches upon prevention measures, as well as climate change.

Strengths

The establishment of an informal network to unite schools across the country in addressing the challenge of climate action and planet protection.

Methodologies

The initiative provides a variety of resources to be employed in the classroom, including handbooks, videos, audio materials and a panel of experts. The participating schools have access to a toolkit featuring up-to-date teaching material on Climate Education, integration into an online collaboration network, promotion of activities, regular support and monitoring and organisation of workshops/trainings.

Users can register on the platform by filling in a form. Membership is free and aimed at students, educators and the school community from schools in Portugal.
