Description

The “Ativa ClimACT” project provides content, resources and initiatives aimed at understanding the causes and consequences of climate change. The objective is to motivate young citizens, but also others, to take proactive steps by equipping them with the necessary tools to become activists and agents of change in this process.

Expected outcomes

The expected outcomes encompass raising awareness among young European citizens about the connections between climate change and development, enhancing the capacity of youth and civil society organizations to address climate issues, and fostering citizens' participation in initiatives to combat climate change.

Climate change

It provides comprehensive content, resources, and initiatives focused on understanding the consequences of climate change.

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Risk prevention

The tool focuses on risk prevention, offering users can access educational resources, such as a compilation of good practices, guidelines and recommendations, as well as films, books and apps.

Management

The initiatives are primarily intended for implementation by educators or schools, although some resources can be explored independently by students.

Others

Relevance to CRISEPAC Objectives

It is relevant to the project as it provides extensive and diverse resources concerning the impacts of climate change, with an emphasis on risk prevention.

Possible adaptations

The available resources are suitable for educators to effectively utilize in a classroom setting, and the workshops and other initiatives can be replicated.

Weaknesses

While it does not explicitly focus on disaster risks, it touches upon prevention measures, as well as climate change.

Strengths

The project is tailored to young Portuguese individuals and accessible language, a dynamic approach, and an appealing appearance, bringing discussions to the schools and communities.

Methodologies

The project features a workshop on climate change, documentaries and debates, a travelling exhibition and conversations with the school/community, which include experts in relevant areas. The website offers information on upcoming climate changes and phenomena for the next decades, along with a quiz to test knowledge.
